## Storis and the Northwest Passage


As a long-time CWOA member, I wanted to let the membership know about a new book, just published, which is full of true stories about a young Coast Guardsman's early life in the Coast Guard, including the historic voyage of three Coast Guard cutters in 1957 through the Arctic ice fields and finding a deep water route across the top of North America.

The book is titled "The Historic Northwest Passage and the CGC Storis – The story of a young man growing up in the Coast Guard in the 1950s." The author, Dick Juge, is a

close friend of mine and served as an engineering petty officer aboard Storis during that voyage.

The story reminds me so much of my own early days in the Coast Guard from the time of my enlistment in 1947, through training school at Groton, CT, and reporting aboard various Coast Guard units, etc. Dick has included some of my own stories in his book and I am pleased to be able to help him in publicizing it.
